CONTEST RULES

Any student currently enrolled at the Grade 1 through 12 level in Essex County and not older than 19 years of age is eligible to enter this contest. Poems may be of any type or style. All poems must be the original work of the poet, previously unpublished. Poems may be submitted in either English or French.

For each poem that you are entering into the contest, please submit a cover page that lists your name, age, school (unless you are home-schooled), mailing address, telephone number and e-mail address (if applicable.) Do not include your personal information on the same page of the poem. Along with the cover sheet, submit two typed copies of the poem.

Each poet may enter up to three poems into the contest. A separate cover sheet must be submitted for each poem.

Poets should keep copies of all entries as they will not be returned. All entries must be postmarked by Tuesday, June 15th, 2010 in order to be considered.

In each age category, First, Second, and Third place poems will be selected in both English and French. The winners will be contacted by mail and by either telephone or e-mail in September 2010. The authors of the winning poems will be eligible to read their poems at BookFestWindsor, Saturday, November 6th, 2010 at the Art Gallery of Windsor. Each winner will receive a cash prize and other gift items.
